

## Minutes of District Executive Improvement Committee (DEIC) Meeting

March 17, 2014

- Meeting called to order at 3:30 by Committee President Jay Stone
- Vision & Mission Statements Workshop
  - Dr. Cavness spoke to committee about the importance of periodically updating and revising the vision and mission statements of the district.
  - He encouraged the committee to attend and spread the word to the community about the upcoming workshop for said revision process because he wanted as many stakeholders in attendance as possible.
  - Workshop is to be held Monday March 24, 2014 at 6:30pm at West Groves Education Center.
- Meet the Teacher Nights
  - It was announced/confirmed that all lower level Meet the Teacher Nights will be held from 4:30-5:30 while at the high school it will continue at its current time and date to coincide with the Fire It Up Pep Rally.
- Review of District Created Instrument for Self Assessment of Accountability
  - TEA has mandated that school districts assess themselves in domains outside related to curriculum and academic success, but not currently measured through testing, attendance records, etc.
    - These areas are:
      - Fine Arts
      - Wellness & Physical Education
      - Community and Parent Involvement
      - 21<sup>st</sup> Century Work Force Development
      - Second Language Acquisition
      - Gifted/Talented
      - Dropout Prevention
      - Digital Learning Environment
      - Compliance
  - TEA has not provided any instrument to assess these areas so district personnel have created one and it is to be reviewed by the DEIC.
  - Revision Process:
    - DEIC was broken into four groups made up of teachers and representatives from each level (Elementary, Middle School, High School).
    - Each group was assigned two domains to assess the measurements of (appropriate/applicable measures, sensibility of scoring of said measures, etc.).
    - All changes were then recommended to Dr. Duhon for review.
