Minutes of the Meeting: March 4, 2015
Location: West Groves Education Center

- Dr. Brenda Duhon, Assistant Superintendent of Curriculum & Instruction/Technology, discussed topics listed below.
 - A proposal will be presented to the school board on Monday, March 9th, to move the Pre-Kindergarten classes at Taft and Woodcrest to the West Groves Education Center. This move is due to a significant enrollment increase at the early elementary levels. Once the school board formally approves this proposal, plans will proceed in a timely to ensure this successful transition for the 2015-2016 school year. The new campus will be called the West Groves Early Learning Center. It will also be classified as a Title I schoolwide campus.
 - PN-G ISD has formed a committee to review facilities at the district's elementary campuses. This committee is in the process of visiting the elementary campuses and studying enrollment projections to assist them with their recommendation to the board. This recommendation could be presented in the fall of this year.
 - The 2014-2015 Community & Student Engagement Survey for elementary campuses was distributed and discussed. Dr. Duhon explained how campuses are now required by TEA to rate themselves in areas other than academics. Areas rated include fine arts, wellness and PE, community and parent involvement, second language acquisition, 21st century work force development, digital learning environment, dropout prevention strategies, educational programs for gifted and talented students, and compliance history.
 - School Report Cards were distributed to committee members according to the campus they represent. Dr. Duhon discussed the information presented and how this information ties into the district's accountability rating.
