Access to Skyward Family Access is a privilege, not a right. Registered parent(s)/guardian(s) will have access to their child's grades, attendance, vaccination compliance records, schedule, demographics, and emergency contacts. The parent(s)/guardian(s) access requires responsibility. To insure users are acting responsibly, administrators and teachers may monitor log on records and e-mail correspondence. Parents and guardians will be held responsible for the proper use of accounts, and the District may suspend or revoke access if rules are violated.


Inappropriate use includes:


HOW DO I LOG ON TO FAMILY ACCESS?

- Go to www.pngisd.org
- Click the *Family Access* icon in the set of icons to the right of the rotating images
- Click the down arrow under the log in information that reads "Login Area" and select "Family/Student Access"
- Enter the login and password provided by the district




When you are logged on, you should see the following menu choices on the left. Click the red "All Students" arrow to select your child's name.

WHAT CAN I SEE IN THE "GRADEBOOK"?


Pre-K and Kindergarten students are graded on mastery of standards. Each subject is listed, so click the arrow to the left of the subject to expand the set of standards.





Middle school and high school gradebooks are not generally available during six weeks' posting windows. As a general rule, this will be the Friday morning that the six weeks ends through either Wednesday or Thursday of the following week.

WHAT CAN I SEE IN ATTENDANCE?



Attendance will be listed in the left pane and a chart will be displayed on the right. The bar chart can be displayed either by period or by day by clicking the appropriate button in the upper right-hand corner.

WHAT CAN I SEE IN STUDENT INFO?

Your child's demographic information is displayed as well as emergency contact information. If this information needs to be updated, please contact your child's school.

WHAT CAN I SEE IN SCHEDULE?

Your child's daily schedule is available in this section.

WHAT CAN I SEE IN TEST SCORES?

STAAR/EOC scores are imported into Skyward.

WHAT CAN I SEE IN PORTFOLIO?

Your child's report cards are available here.

WHAT CAN I SEE IN HEALTH?

Your child's shot records are posted here.

WHAT CAN I SEE IN LOGIN HISTORY

This is a record of when your Family Access account was accessed.
