 - A minimum of two Internet links related to course content
 - Link to District Curriculum Maps (Link to be provided)

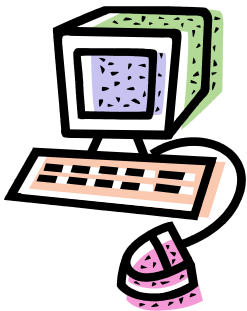
Optional* (May post ONLY if related to curriculum)

- Daily or Weekly Agenda (Possible Suggestions)
 - PreK – 3: Weekly Classroom Topics
 - Grades 4 – 8: Weekly Agenda
