

## IMMUNIZATION CLINICS

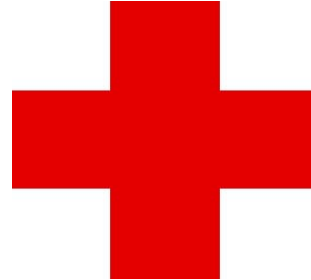

<b>Texas State Law Requirements for Immunizations</b>	
<b>DTP/DTap</b>	Five doses unless 4 <sup>th</sup> dose was given on or after 4 <sup>th</sup> birthday.
<b>Polio-IPV</b>	Four doses unless the 3 <sup>rd</sup> dose was given on or after 4 <sup>th</sup> birthday.
<b>MMR</b> (Measles, Mumps, Rubella)	Two doses with the 1 <sup>st</sup> dose on or after 1 <sup>st</sup> birthday. Second dose by age 5 or entry into kindergarten.
<b>HIB</b>	Required for children 18 months until age 5.
<b>Hepatitis B</b>	Three doses are required.
<b>Hepatitis A</b>	Two doses on or after 2 <sup>nd</sup> birthday for Early Childhood students.
<b>Pneumococcal Conjugate</b> (PCV-7, Prevnar)	Three doses - Age 2-6. Required for age 2 months -59 months or if in Early Childhood or daycare program.
<b>Varicella</b>	One dose on or after 1 <sup>st</sup> birthday. (2 <sup>nd</sup> dose recommended)
<b>TB Test</b>	Recommended by the State Health Department.
<b>Tetanus Booster</b>	Required every 10 years even though the child may have received 5 DPT immunizations.
<b>All immunization records must include day as well as month &amp; year &amp; be verified by a signature or stamp of clinic or person administering the vaccine.</b>
