

Dear Parents,

All students have the right to a school setting that is safe, orderly, efficient, and free from disruption. Now that your child is in first grade, he/she should be responsible for his/her actions. I will be keeping you informed on a weekly basis.

If a student breaks a rule, he/she will pull a colored ticket that matches the rule he/she broke and put that ticket in his/her pocket. He/She will face daily consequences depending on the number of tickets he/she has in his / her pocket.

Below is a list of the rules and the consequences.

Rules

1. Raise hand and wait to be called on.
2. Do not talk without permission.
3. Follow directions.
4. Sit in your chair
5. Walk in the building.
6. Keep hands, feet, and objects where they belong.
7. Respect authority.
8. Respect the rights of others.

Consequences

- 0-2 tickets - warning
- 3 tickets - miss half of recess
- 4 tickets - miss all of recess
- 5 tickets - note home to parents
- 6 tickets - meet with the principal

If major offense - sent to office immediately.

Conduct Grading Scale – Weekly

- 0 tickets - Excellent
- 1-2 tickets - S+
- 3-4 tickets - S
- 5 tickets - S-
- 6 tickets - N
- 7 or more - U
